COMMENTS: HARRIS POLL ON MARIJUANA LEGALIZATION

The latest Harris Poll indicated a 4 year uptrend, reporting that 4 of 5 adults, or 81% favor legalizing medical marijuana.

This is not a surprise. This approval was up from 74% in 2011.

Clearly, medical marijuana is here to stay. It is highly beneficial in most aspects for human health.

The bogy is that recreational marijuana at 49% is still in the lower than half (50%) of the national support level. The poll stated that 42% approved of recreational in 2011.

Recreational marijuana is the problem. If this 49% approval drops further, it tells me that families and concerns for children and young adults is a national and growing concern as the nation begins to understand the power of THC.

This issue has been a political football. The poll cited that 9 in 10 Democrats and Independents responded favorably supporting medical marijuana by 87% and 86% respectively. The same group reported 58% and 55% supporting recreational.

Note that Republicans supported medical by 69% with only 23% opposing medical. Clearly Republicans represent family values as only 27% supported recreational.

There is a wide gap between Democrats, Independents and Republicans. If Hillary Clinton is elected in 2016, she will represent a more liberal Party stance. A Republican President could represent the opposite.
