NFL ON POT

NFL WRITER DAN HANZUS:

THE NFL AND MOST PROFESSIONAL SPORTS VIEW MARIJUANA CONTRARY TO THE CANNABIS INDUSTRY. THEIR REASONS ARE WELL DOCUMENTED IN ATHLETE'S PERFORMANCE UNDER POT.

NFL COMMISSIONER ROGER GOODELL CAN RULE ON THE CASE AT ANY TIME. A SHORT TIME AFTER REPORTS SURFACED OF HIS FAILED DRUG TEST, GORDON POSTED THIS ON TWITTER: CALL ME IF U NEED A REAL STORY WORTH WRITING. FLASH GORDON (@JOSH_GORDONXII) APRIL 11, 2016

IN FEBRUARY 2015, GORDON WAS SUSPENDED WITHOUT PAY FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR FOR VIOLATING THE NFL POLICY AND PROGRAM FOR SUBSTANCES OF ABUSE. GORDON TESTED POSITIVE FOR ALCOHOL, AND LATER ACKNOWLEDGED HE HAD TWO BEERS AND TWO COCKTAILS ON A PRIVATE JET TO LAS VEGAS.

THE 2015 SEASON REPRESENTED THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR IN WHICH GORDON SERVED A BAN FOR VIOLATING THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM. THE 24 YEAR OLD MANAGED TO LEAD THE NFL IN RECEIVING IN 2013 DESPITE A TWO-GAME BAN TO START THE SEASON."
