SESSIONS HEARING

Sessions said he did not recall any. Factually he was accused of lying.

Sessions replied: "I'm not able to be rushed this fast. It makes me nervous."

Sessions denied collusion with the Russian government.

He would not reveal conversations he had with the President. He was also apparently not aware of certain aspects of the law.

The bottom line is that it looks unlikely that Sessions will resign or be forced to resign.

It is bad news for the cannabis industry if he gets away with stonewalling, lying and remains in office. This man appears to many to not be qualified as the Nation's Attorney General.
