Potential Disease Conditions Treated by Cannabis

- Cannabis may have medical value in some of the following disease conditions:
- Multiple sclerosis, epilepsy, hepatitis C, Parkinson's disease, chronic pain, anxiety
- ADD/ADHA, alcoholism, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), atherosclerosis (hardening of the arteries), autism, bipolar disorder, brain trauma, cancer Crohn's disease
- Cystic fibrosis, depression, dermatitis, diabetes, dystonia, eczema, edema, epilepsy, fibromyalgia, gastro-esophageal reflux disease (GERD), glaucoma, hepatitis, herpes,
- Human immunodeficiency virus, acquired immune deficiency syndrome (HIV/AIDS)
- Huntington's Disease, irritable bowel syndrome (IBS), menopause, migraines
- Morning sickness, methicillin resistant staphylococcus aureus (MSRA/Staph), Multiple sclerosis (MS)
- Muscular dystrophy, nausea, neuropathic pain, osteoporosis, pain, pancreatitis, Parkinson's disease, post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), pruritus (chronic itch), restless leg syndrome (RLS), sickle cell disease
- Spasticity, spinal cord injury, stroke, Tourette's syndrome, ulcerative colitis.
