Is the Recreational Market for Real?

- Former White House spokesman, Robert Weiner spoke at an American University meeting.
- Weiner's comments are not to be taken lightly. He knows this field cold.
- His comments included very concerning observations regarding recreational marijuana.
- "He cited little-reported "harms of marijuana" in states that have already legalized, including increased usage, more car crashes, more hospital emergency room cases, and drug treatment center admission increases, and in "medical marijuana" states, over 90% fraudulent cases of medical claims in marijuana clinics according to law enforcement sources.
- "I know the harm that is done by car crashes, DUIs, date rape and the impact of flooding already overcrowded emergency rooms...from marijuana, which most 'legalizers' claim they want to separate from 'harder' drugs."
- Statistics from Colorado include increased homeless and other concerns. It is clear that marijuana holds potential health harm and enormous negative social consequences, especially for the younger generation.
- Long term investors in the recreational market should take notice.
