The Ruderalis Cannabis Plant

- Ruderalis marijuana plants were native and came from Europe.
- Ruderalis are typically smaller than most marijuana plant varieties.
- Their normal size is between one and three feet.
- Ruderalis are not a significant component of commercial modern cannabis growing
- Ruderalis are, however, sometimes used for cross breeding with both sativas and indicas.
- Sativas and Indicas flower in specific time and daylight periods.
- Ruderalis are auto flowering, based on age, not primarily dependent on specific light periods.
- Breeders cross breed Ruderalis with both sativas and indicas to keep and maintain auto-flowering, while at the same time, targeting high THC levels
- Ruderalis germination time periods are normally between 100 and 120 days.
- As an investor, you do not need to become a Ruderalis expert. Rather, knowing the different varieties of marijuana plants will help you understand cannabis investment business models.
