The cannabis industry hyped this election as being key to the industry's progress on legalization.

Clearly the results were a clear statement against recreational marijuana in Ohio. It was a resounding defeat.

Perhaps the state might try again in 2016, or push for medical marijuana.

However, this vote is telling, and in my view has implications for national acceptance and legalization.

The recent national poll reported a 58% pro marijuana legalization.

Yet, Ohio ran completely opposite with only a 35% positive vote. We cannot over look this disparity.

I wonder about the real life acceptance of cannabis and the validity of these polls.

Is Ohio simply a conservative mid America state not turned on to marijuana?

Or does this vote express a national sentiment? Will California follow this result?

Time will tell. I see at this time a real battle ground in California a year from now.
